A productive machine.

1 A JCB Construction Loadall is extremely manoeuvrable making it easy to operate in confined spaces; the compact wheelbase and large steering lock angles save you valuable travel time on site.

2 Loadalls come with 4WD as standard (optional 2WD can also be selected to minimise tyre wear and fuel use when roading), helping you maintain plenty of traction and performance in soft, muddy areas. A limited slip differential in the front axle is an option too.*

Productive lifting and hydraulics.

3 JCB's optional Smoothride System (SRS)* cushions shocks from the boom, improving load retention and increasing operator comfort (and therefore productivity) when travelling at speed on the road or on uneven fields.

*Model dependant

The JCB Loadall construction range offers either a 63kw (85hp), 74kw (100hp) or a 97kw (130hp) DIESELMAX engine (model dependant), for optimal machine matching to the environment.

4 The JCB quickhitch system makes attachment-changing quick and easy.

5 For the most efficient lifting, extending and pushing – our class-leading hydraulics will give you the fastest cycle times.

On our three and four stage boom machines we fit stabilisers for increased stability and lift performance (not 535-95).

The JCB-built DIESELMAX engine produces its power and high torque at low engine speeds for great responsiveness, and our range of loadall models means you can find the perfect machine for your requirements, whether that be travelling on the road to handling material on site.





Productive controls.

6 A Construction Loadall has three selectable steer modes. There's two wheel steer, which is ideal for travelling at high speed on the road; four-wheel steer for working in tight spaces; and crab steer for manoeuvring close to walls and buildings.

An optional reversing fan can be used to clear dust and debris from the cooling system to maintain performance.

7 For added versatility, all JCB Loadalls are fitted as standard with a single boom auxiliary feature which can power a wide range of attachments.

THE JCB LOADALL IS A HIGHLY VERSATILE MACHINE WITH ADDED DURABILITY, LIFT CAPACITIES OF UP TO 4,100KG, LIFT HEIGHTS OF UP TO 16.7M AND A WIDE RANGE OF ATTACHMENTS, THE JCB LOADALL CAN REPLACE THE NEED FOR HIRING EXTRA MACHINES SUCH AS CRANES, LOADING SHOVELS, FORK LIFT TRUCKS, SWEEPERS AND AERIAL WORK PLATFORMS. 1 The JCB DIESELMAX engine has been designed from scratch to give you performance you can depend on.

2 It's an amazing piece of engineering, featuring an advanced combustion system that not only complies with Tier 3 Stage 3 emissions, but with future Tier 4/ Stage 4 compliance built into the engine design. So, with minimal installation changes required in the next decade, this engine is an excellent business investment for today and tomorrow.



Further efficiency.

3 A JCB Construction Loadall is a great asset in so many respects, not least financially – huge global demand, plus legendary productivity, plus superb build quality equals maximum resale value.

4 High back-off brakes on 531-70, 541-70, 535-95 and 533-105 reduce viscous drag during roading and rehandling, which improves fuel economy by up to 2%.

Lower Powershift oil levels deliver 1% fuel savings.

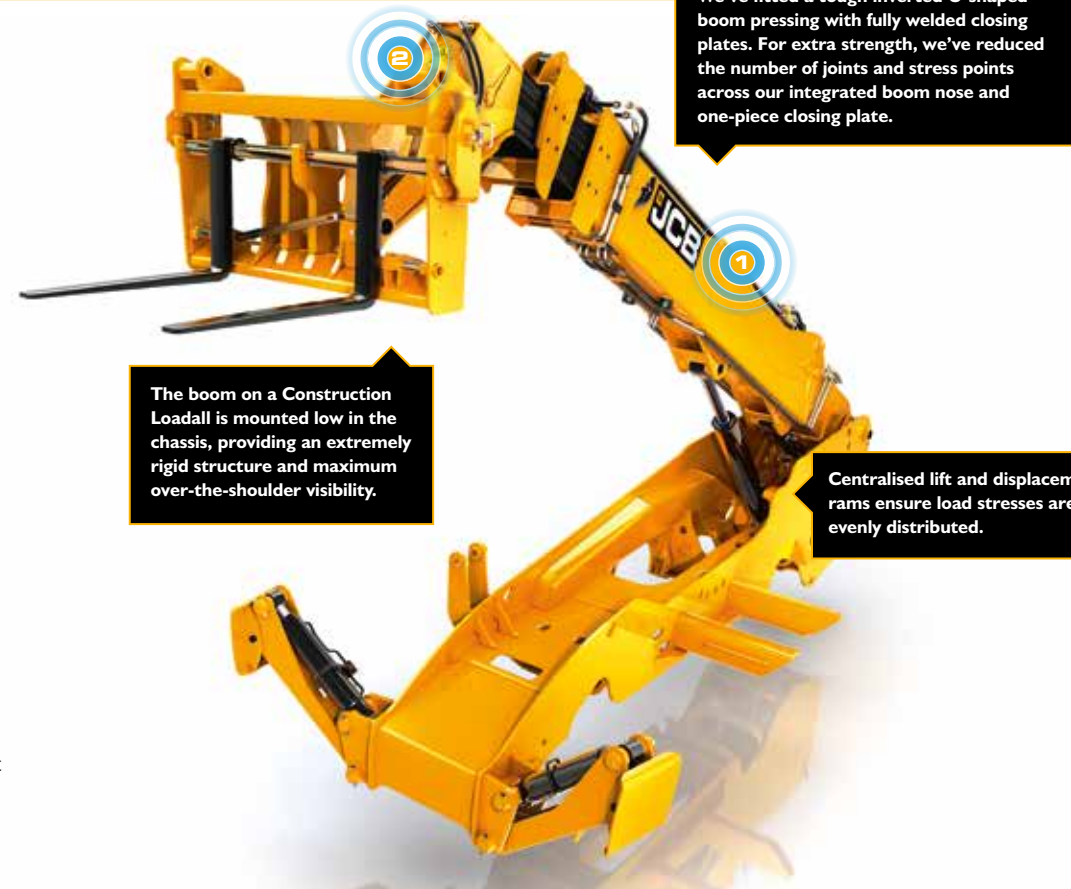
Tough boom design.

- 1 For ultimate strength and durability, we've built in large boom overlaps of more than 1.0m on all of our machines.
- 2 Hoses are routed through the boom for maximum protection.

Built-in protection.

- 3 Bonnets on Construction Loadalls are protected from damage by being side-mounted on the chassis and recessed.
- 4 Our Construction Loadalls have fold-up rear lights that can be kept clear and well protected from on-site damage.
- 5 Opt for front and top screen roof guards for added protection from falling objects.

- 6 Heavy-duty axle feet help a Construction Loadall to absorb the stresses generated during material rehandling applications.
- To protect our Construction Loadalls from corrosion over the long term, we dip the cab in electrophoretic alloy before painting it.



We've fitted a tough inverted U-shaped boom pressing with fully welded closing plates. For extra strength, we've reduced the number of joints and stress points across our integrated boom nose and one-piece closing plate.

The boom on a Construction Loadall is mounted low in the chassis, providing an extremely rigid structure and maximum over-the-shoulder visibility.

Centralised lift and displacement rams ensure load stresses are evenly distributed.

Durable components.

7 The new Construction Loadall range's stringent testing programme has included prolonged high stress loading of the chassis, boom and other key components, as well as cold climate testing and repeated transmission use over thousands of cycles.

8 The lift, tilt and extension rams are held in place by keyhole castings for even greater structural integrity.

9 To prove how good our DIESELMAX engines are, we've tested them in 70 different machines across the toughest applications and environments.

10 The one-piece fully welded chassis maximises strength and minimises weight.

11 At JCB, we make our own hydraulic cylinders, cabs, axles, transmissions and engines – all designed to work in perfect harmony for optimum reliability.



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A SLICK OPERATION.

JCB LOADALL OFFERS BEST-IN-CLASS COMFORT WITH: ONE OF THE LARGEST CABS IN THE INDUSTRY, CLASS-LEADING NOISE LEVELS, EXCELLENT AIRFLOW, VENTILATION AND DEMISTING, WITH OPTIONAL AIR CONDITIONING, AND A FULLY ADJUSTABLE SUSPENSION SEAT AND STEERING COLUMN FOR THE OPTIMUM DRIVING POSTURE. THE WHOLE POINT OF ANY CAB IS TO PUT THE OPERATOR IN CONTROL, AND JCB LOADALL DOES THIS WITH SIMPLICITY AND STYLE. Ergonomic controls.

- 1 JCB cab offers a uniform airflow, hot or cold to the operator through 8 different vents generating a comfortable operator environment.
- 2 Backlit switches are crystal clear, even in the dark.
- 3 To create the perfect driving position, opt for the easily adjustable tilting telescopic steering column.



On bright days, a Construction Loadall's standard-fit tinted cab glass will reflect 30% of the sun's energy for enhanced operator comfort.



Comfort and convenience.

4 The optional cab, front, rear and boom work lights provide excellent visibility.

5 Visibility on a Construction Loadall is excellent, courtesy of direct glazing large roof screen and low profile bonnet.

In addition we have angled our roof bars to ensure maximum visibility when placing at height.

6 On our 540-170 Construction Loadalls we have fitted a servo joystick for fast and precise control (optional on a 535-140/535-125).

7 The exterior top door slam latch is new – you can now close the upper door from outside and hold the door ajar.



SAFE AND SECURE.

1 For quick, easy and safe access, JCB Construction Loadalls have a three-point access and two cab steps.

2 Hose burst check valves on the rams prevent collapse if a hose fails.

3 A JCB Construction Loadall has excellent rearward and off-side visibility, courtesy of a low boom and bonnet profile and low boom pivot.

4 A JCB Loadall comes equipped with a full set of side and rear view mirrors for all round visibility and safety compliance.

For extra safety, a reverse alarm is standard-fit on all construction Loadalls.

5 JCB factory-fit immobilisers, can either be activated by a unique key or optional push button PIN system, that automatically arm themselves after a certain period following engine shutdown. LiveLink available in certain territories.



JCB Adaptive Load Control automatically controls hydraulic operation to help maintain the longitudinal stability of your Construction Loadall.



The operator presence switch on Construction Loadalls disables drive when an operator leaves their seat; this prevents accidental operation.

LESS SERVICING, MORE SERVICE.

1 All daily checks, greasing and serviceable components can be accessed at ground level.

The filters on a Loadall (engine oil, hydraulic oil and fuel) are centrally located for fast, easy servicing. The air filter is easily accessible, and its double-element design simplifies cleaning. The fact that we design our Construction Loadalls to be fast and easy to service, ensures we have best-in-class SAE serviceability ratings.

2 You can access a Construction Loadall's battery easily (and without specialist tools) via a lockable cover that's opened with the ignition key.

3 The diesel tank is also easy to get to, and can be filled from ground level. For protection from dirty fuel, there's an integral pre-filter in the filler neck.

4 A dry lubricant system means a Loadall's wear pads are extremely durable, with service intervals of 500 hours.

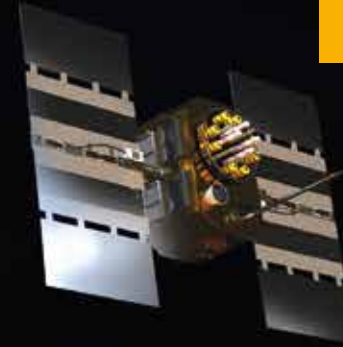
